SHOW RULES

1. You may enter up to a maximum of 3 items in any class in this Schedule – subject to:
 - a. meeting the age requirements of Classes 62-76; and
 - b. a Class Judge may not enter any Item that s/he is due to judge.
2. Please use the entry form in this Schedule (download extra copies from the Bucknell Show website (<http://www.thebucknellshow.co.uk>) or photocopy it), one form per competitor, and get the form with the entry fee to Clare Cottage, Sitwell Close, Bucknell NO LATER than 5.00pm on 5th September 2019.
3. **Exhibitors' cards will be available from Clare Cottage between 5.00pm and 9.00pm on 6th September 2019. Exceptionally, exhibitors' cards may be collected at the time of staging (see 4. below), but this may involve entrants having to queue.**
4. Staging of exhibits at the Daffodil Lane site starts at 9.00am on 7th September 2019 and must be completed by 10.30am in time for judging.
5. The name (and age for classes 62-76) of the exhibitor must not be visible to the judge.
6. Save for floral art materials etc, all exhibits are to be grown, made, crafted or created by the exhibitor.
7. Entries in Classes 26-44 may not include a prize-winning item from any previous year.
8. The Bucknell Show Committee cannot be held responsible for any exhibit.
9. Exhibits are not to be removed from the site before 5.00pm, but should be collected as soon as possible thereafter.
10. With the exception of Class 25, prizes will be awarded as follows:
Open Classes: 1st £1-50, 2nd £1-00, 3rd 50p; Young People: 1st £1-00, 2nd 50p, 3rd 20p.

COOKERY CLASS 51: PRESCRIBED RECIPE

Mocha Fudge Cake with Coffee Icing

FOR THE ICING	FOR THE CAKE
175g/6oz plain chocolate, melted	300g/10oz plain flour
50g/2oz butter, melted	2 tsp baking powder
15ml/¼ pint double-strength espresso	1 tsp vanilla extract
1 tsp vanilla extract	3 eggs, separated
300g/10oz icing sugar	125ml/4fl oz milk
	4 tbsp instant coffee granules
	85g/3oz butter
	280g/10oz caster sugar
	85g/3oz plain chocolate, melted
	125ml/4fl oz soured cream

Method

1. Whisk together the cooled icing ingredients. Cover and set aside for 3-4 hours.
2. Preheat the oven to 180°C/Gas 4/fan oven 160°C.
3. Grease and line two 20cm/8in cake tins.
4. Melt the cake chocolate.
5. Sift the flour and baking powder together.
6. Stir the vanilla into the egg yolks.
7. Heat half the milk to boiling point, stir in the coffee to dissolve; then add the rest of the milk and cool.
8. Cream the butter and 200g/8oz of the caster sugar.
9. Slowly whisk in the egg yolk mixture; then the melted chocolate.
10. Fold in the sifted dry ingredients, the cooled milk and the soured cream.
11. Whisk the egg whites until stiff; then whisk in the remaining sugar to form firm peaks.
12. Fold the egg whites into the cake mixture and then pour into the tins.
13. Bake for 35 minutes until risen.
14. Leave in tins for 5 minutes and then turn out to cool on rack.
15. When cold, sandwich the cakes together with some of the icing.
16. Finally, cover the top with the remaining icing.

GENERAL GUIDANCE ON SHOWING

VEGETABLES may be presented on appropriately sized paper plates.

PHOTOGRAPHS are to be unmounted, but may be stuck on card not exceeding the stipulated picture size.

COOKERY CLASS entries should: (a) be on a firm plate or board (not paper plate); and (b) have a clear removable covering.

PRESERVES CLASS jars are to be clear, colourless, glass with a screw top.

YOUNG PEOPLE'S PHOTOGRAPHS, PAINTINGS or DRAWINGS are to be unmounted, but may be stuck on card not exceeding the stipulated picture size.
