Local staff changes

September will see some changes to the Bishop's Castle Policing Team, as of the 29th September, PC Stuart Coote will be moving to Church Stretton Police Station and covering the Craven Arms area. PC Coote will be replaced by PC 21989 Daryl McWatt who moves from Ludlow.

The government have allocated funding for West Mercia Police from the neighbourhood policing grant to be spent on local policing, as a result this has permitted a new post for an extra PC to be stationed at Bishop's Castle Police Station, this will be PC 21006 Simon Wilkey who joins from Oswestry.

As of the 10th September, Police Community Support Officer's shifts have been changed so they no longer work until 10pm and now work no later than 8pm. Prior to this in 2023, PCSO's had a similar change to duty hours where working until midnight was reduced to 10pm. This is a cost saving measure by West Mercia.

Court sentencing

On Monday 15th September, 7 men who were part of a gang that have plagued the area were sentenced to a combined total of more than 25 years for their part in rural thefts and burglaries across south Shropshire and Powys.

Farms in south Shropshire were the main target, with agricultural equipment such as tractors, ATV's, quad bikes, trailers and 4x4 pick-ups being targeted and stolen. The thefts were carried out in rural locations and often under the cover of darkness, meaning officers relied on CCTV, forensics and phone work to identify the suspects.

The investigation led to identifying seven men linked to the thefts. Officers uncovered that the men were also responsible for burglaries in Montgomeryshire, Powys which were being investigated by Dyfed-Powys Police. Working together, the two forces began to collate and collect evidence relating to over 150 offences spanning over a number of years.

On Thursday 20th March 2024, West Mercia Police along with officers from Dyfed-Powys Police carried out a series of warrants at addresses in Broseley, Cross Houses and Telford, where seven men were arrested.

All seven men were then charged with conspiracy to steal from another.

It's estimated, during their crime spree, the organised crime gang stole agricultural equipment worth between £5million and £10million.

On Monday 15th September they were sentenced at Shrewsbury Crown Court after pleading guilty at a previous hearing. The men are:

- Andrew Baker, aged 36, of Lovell Close in Shifnal, Shropshire, sentenced to four years and five months
 - Christopher Downes, aged 35, of Park View in Broseley, Shropshire, sentenced to seven months
 - Thomas Nutt, aged 27, of Bridgnorth Road in Broseley, Shropshire, sentenced to four years and five months
 - Wayne Price, aged 32, of Cross Houses in Shrewsbury, Shropshire, sentenced to nine years
- Dean Rogerson, aged 34, of Homelands Park in Ketley Bank, Telford, Shropshire, sentenced to three years and one-month
- Neil Shevlin, aged 32, of Four Winds in Norton, Shifnal, Shropshire, sentenced to one-year and two months
 - Ryan Taylor, aged 32, of Hayward Parade in Telford, Shropshire, sentenced to two years and six months
