Shropshire Council report October 2022

Due to my current Covid status, here is a very brief SC report as agreed.

Things are still quite quiet at Shropshire Council.

There is a SC by-election currently taking place: - **Bridgnorth West & Tasley**: Election day is Thursday 6th October (Cause: Death of Councillor). There is a Local government Boundary Commission review upcoming & the Shropshire submission is that we need a further 2 Councillors to take us up from 74 to 76 (based primarily on population growth).

In a report to Cabinet Shropshire residents could be forced to pay for green bin collections in fight to cut £33m waste bill – **Scrutiny** are sending comments to Cabinet for them to consider. Government help is going to be made available for those off the gas grid. The Government have said they will help all of us off the gas grid with £100 towards our high LPG, oil and coal bills. They have not found a way to pay it yet.....!

Following a recent tendering exercise involving the 738/740 Knighton to Ludlow bus service, Minsterley Motors have now been confirmed as the successful operator and they will be operating this service w.e.f Tuesday 1st November 2022. The times of the bus & the route remain unchanged.
